THE HISTORY OF EAGLE U

GENERAL INFORMATION

What Exactly IS Eagle U?

Eagle U is five day youth leadership retreat experience for students between the ages of 15 to 25 years of age. Students arrive on Monday morning and depart on Friday. The entire program is held on a college campus. All students remain on the campus overnight and during the entire duration of the program. Students come from all over the country - Eagle U provides private transportation to and from the airport for the students that fly in.

Eagle U is an "edutainment experience" because students experience five intense, jam packed days that are equal parts fun entertainment and education! The structure of the program is a combination seminars, handson activities, and small group discussions.

The Curriculum

The Eagle U curriculum includes:

A featured session is the Mentor Roundtable. The Roundtable is an opportunity for our students to learn from successful individuals from various industries and backgrounds. "It takes a lifetime to learn from your own experiences, but it only takes a conversation to learn from someone else's. Why create mediocrity when you can copy genius?". Students practice their interview and communication skills and borrow wisdom from the mentors they engage with.


Who do the sponsorships benefit?

You may either select your student(s) outright or hold a scholarship contest.


SELECT your students! Eagle U will provide you with all the information and marketing materials you will need to get the word out and select your students!

Once you've selected your students, award them with their certificate! Then email their information to Taylor Lowe and the Eagle U team will take it from there on getting them registered and completing their paperwork!

SELECTING YOUR STUDENTS

Once you or your organization has decided to sponsor, the exciting part of selecting the lucky student(s) begins!

Two Options for Student Selection:



If you already know the specific student(s) you want to send, feel free to award them a scholarship as soon as possible! Otherwise you can work to identify and select the student(s) you wish to send.

• Selecting a deserving student from the community:

- Connect and work with your local high schools, trade schools, and community organizations (Big Brother Big Sisters, Boys and Girls Club, Scouts, etc.)
- Inform and educate these local partners about the Eagle U opportunity using the provided marketing materials and informational video. Ask them to help identify and/or select deserving students to fill your scholarship spots.

Selecting a student from your interns, team member's children, patients, or clients:

- Start by educating your office and team about Eagle U and what the opportunity is by using the provided marketing materials and informational video.
- Set a deadline for all nominations or applications then internally select your student.

Once you've selected the student(s), email their names to Taylor Lowe and Eagle U will create a custom certificate for your student! Award the scholarship with the certificate and take a picture of the student to post in your office, on social media, etc!



SCHOLARSHIP CONTEST SUGGESTIONS

Holding a scholarship contest is completely optional. If you choose to hold a contest, feel free to do so any way you'd like - below are just some ideas to get you started!

- Have a team meeting to explain to your team what Eagle U is and how it can positively impact a
 deserving student, as well as your business. Make sure every member on the team can answer
 basic questions about the program if asked by a potential student or parent. Log onto the Eagle U
 website together to read more about the program, watch the informational videos, and read the
 FAQ's.
- Decide when you want to run your contest. We suggest choosing a concise 2-week time span in order to make it an efficient and fun process for your office!
- Decide what is required for students to enter the contest. For example, you can ask interested applicants to submit an essay to your office on WHY they are deserving of the scholarship. All students will have to develop long-form answers to a variety of questions on their Student Application once chosen by your office!
- Customize our promotional flier with your office name and logo and place in an 8.5" x 11" clear, acrylic counter stand on your front desk and include in your email campaigns and social media posts.
- Post weekly messages about the Eagle U Scholarship opportunity on your social media pages reminding applicants about the offer and the deadline.
- Have each team member talk about the scholarship to all clients and team members, especially those with high school or college age children or grandchildren.
- Send a promotional email to all relevant contacts in your email database.
- Send a press release to all of your local news media outlets.
- At the end of the contest, determine the winner as a team. We suggest the team read all of the contestants essays and determine together by a majority vote who is most worthy of the opportunity.
- Contact the winner and arrange a time when he or she can come to your office.
- Ask Eagle U for a winner's certificate and present it to the student! (Email Taylor Lowe and we will
 create one for you). When the winner comes to your office, take pictures of the team awarding
 the recipient with the certificate. Post the pictures on your social media pages, linking it to the
 Eagle U page.

Dates and Location -
